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Hello and welcome to the *Kabetogama Sanitary Sewer Collection and Treatment Project Status Update*. In this and later issues, we will be updating you periodically on the status of this project.

Happening Now

We hope you all have had a wonderful summer and have enjoyed your time at Lake Kabetogama. Now that we are settling into fall, we plan to get a few tasks completed throughout the project area before cold temperatures set in.

Many of you have already filled out a Temporary License Form, but for anyone that has not, we have included a copy with this letter for each property owner to review and sign. This form will grant only temporary permission for essential work and survey data collection to be carried out on your property, which is crucial for progressing with the design of this project. We encourage all property owners to carefully review, sign, and return the temporary license forms at your earliest convenience. Forms can be electronically signed, or physically signed, scanned, and emailed to: cbruce@sehinc.com. We will then forward to the Township to complete the signing process.

SEH plans to have an archeologist perform their review throughout the project area the week of October 6th. This review will involve an archeological survey to review evidence of archeological sites with a site walkthrough and shovel testing if deemed necessary. This work will take roughly 10 days to complete.

Prior to the archeological review, SEH surveyors will be present throughout the project site and will stake out features of our project design which includes grinder station locations and piping alignments throughout each individual property. This work is anticipated to take place sometime during the week of September 29th. Please avoid disturbing the stakes as this information is critical for the archeologist to see as they are performing their review. Our surveyors will wear SEH vests and be walking throughout the project area.

SEH will also perform a wetland delineation throughout the project area from October 1st through the 3rd. The process includes field data collection on vegetation, hydrology, and soils. Our field crew will wear SEH vests and be walking the proposed piping alignment.

Once the archeological review is completed, SEH will have Braun Intertec perform soil borings throughout the project area where the proposed grinder stations and treatment sites will be located. This work is not anticipated to occur until sometime in November. We will be sure send another Project Status Update letter to notify you of the exact dates that this work will be performed.

Please look forward to additional project details in the upcoming Project Status Updates and do not hesitate to reach out if you have any questions. We hope you all enjoy a wonderful fall.

TEMPORARY LICENSE

_____ (“Grantor”), does hereby grant to the Township of Kabetogama, Minnesota (“Grantee”), its assignees and successors, a revocable license and authority, for a term of three (3) years (April, 2025 to April, 2028), to enter upon the following described premises for the purpose of and subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter stated, to all of which the Grantee agrees:

1. The licensed premises are legally described as: _____
(the “Licensed Premises”).
2. The purpose of this revocable license is to permit the Grantee to enter upon the Licensed Premises to perform the following operations (the “Operations”): soil borings, sampling of surficial sediment and survey works, including but not limited to the digging of eight (8) to ten (10) holes on each site with an auger bit affixed to a backhoe, or mini excavator and then backfilling immediately afterwards.
3. The Grantee shall perform its Operations on the Licensed Premises in a good and workmanlike manner.
4. The Grantee shall comply with all federal, state, county and municipal laws, ordinances and regulations which are applicable to the Grantee’s Operations on the Licensed Premises.
5. The Grantee shall accept the Licensed Premises ‘as is’ and that no claims resulting from injury or death as a result of the condition of the Licensed Premises shall be the fault of or the responsibility of the Grantor.
6. Nothing in this temporary license shall render the Grantee responsible for any pre-existing contamination, pollution or other hazardous materials on the Licensed Premises.
7. The Grantee may subcontract a portion of the performed Operations on the Licensed Premises.
8. This Agreement may be executed by scanned signatures and concurrently in counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original, but all of which together will constitute one and the same instrument.
