Authorizing its representatives to prepare application for 2026 Community Directed Spending

WHEREAS, THE VNPCWJPB HAS DEVELOPED AND IMPLEMENTED A PLAN TO CLEAN THE WATERS OF VOYAGEURS NATIONAL PARK, MINNESOTA'S ONLY NATIONAL PARK AND OUR NATION'S ONLY WATER BASED NATIONAL PARK, AND:

AND WHEREAS, THIS FUNDING AND PROJECT HAVE HAD A POSITIVE IMPACT ON THE WATERS OF VOYAGEURS NATIONAL PARK AND THE BOUNDARY WATERS CANOE AREA WILDERNESS, AND;

AND WHEREAS, THE BOARD HAS HAD GREAT SUCCESS, ESTABLISHING SANITARY SEWER DISTRICTS AND PROJECTS IN THREE OF THE FOUR MAIN ENTRANCES TO THE PARK, WORKING WITH THE MINNESOTA POLLUTION CONTROL AGENCY, PUBLIC FACILITIES AUTHORITY, U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, U.S. ARMY CORP OF ENGINEERS, THE MINNESOTA CLEAN WATER COUNCIL, AND MANY OTHERS TO BRING FUNDING TO THIS EFFORT, AND;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE VNPCWJB AUTHORIZES ITS REPRESENTATIVES AND STAFF TO PREPARE A FEDERAL COMMUNITY DIRECTED SPENDING APPLICATION TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT THROUGH THE OFFICES OF SEN. AMY KLOBUCHAR, SEN. TINA SMITH, AND REP. PETE STAUBER FOR A FEDERAL EARMARK OF \$4 MILLION DOLLARS FOR CONTINUATION OF THE CLEAN WATER PROJECT.

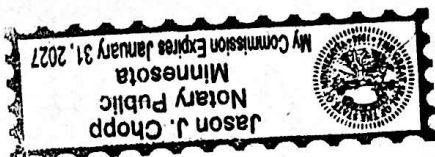
